

2024 CZWKA Membership

Your annual CZWKA (Canadian Japan Karate do Federation Wado-Kai) membership is now due for 2024 and will be debited from your account, as it has been in previous years, around January 25th. The fee for junior kyu (colored) belts, 16 years and under is \$20.00, senior kyu (colored) belts, 17 years and over is \$40.00 and black belts are \$60.00. The CZWKA membership is important because it confirms your belt level achieved at any recognized branch worldwide. Being part of an established Karate association allows for additional training opportunities both locally and worldwide. This membership is also integral for black belt certification when your time comes. (Please note; if you joined the dojo last year, your 2023 membership was included with

your registration.)

During the colder months, please keep in mind how we can all play a part in keeping the boot room clean and easy for karatigas to enter and exit during class times. We have replaced the boot racks and are now more stable and easier for students to use. When hanging up coats, if taller karatigas could use the higher racks, that would be greatly appreciated for the younger ones to try hanging their own coats on the lower racks. We know that sometimes it can look like a tornado blew through that room and are hoping we can all help to keep a clear pathway during the next few months. Tax receipts and T2202

Please be advised there is only one method available for requesting tax receipts, by going to our website, www.sentenashikarate.com. Tax receipts has its own tab at the top of the page and is easily accessible. Be sure to include all the relevant information asked for. It may take up to 30 days to process so please plan ahead.

Sentenashi Karate School is an approved Certified Educational Institution by Employment and Social Development Canada (ESDC) 7009/12091. We can provide our students who are at least sixteen years of age on December 31 of the taxation year a T2202 Form – Tuition, Education and Textbook Amount. The tax credits for tuition, education amounts and textbooks are non-refundable tax credits. There is a Federal tax credit as well as a provincial or territorial tax credit for tuition, education and textbook amounts. For this reason, to claim these amounts, or to transfer them to another person, you must complete both the Federal Schedule 11 of your tax return, and the provincial S(11) schedule. The eligible tuition fees include monthly tuition fees, membership fees and grading fees. Monthly fees will be automatically issued to the qualifying students. (Student membership fees and grading fees must be calculated and submitted through the website by the end of January if you would like it included in the tuition fees.) Tuition fees do not include any cost for uniforms, equipment or weapons. Taxpayers may claim tuition fees on their tax return only if they are over \$100.

Students who wish to transfer some or all of their unused tuition, education and textbook amounts must be aware of the restrictions involved, both as to whom transfers can be made, and as to the amount that can be transferred. Eligible students can also claim the Education and Tax amount. *Please speak to your accountant for more details*.
